valued

At Priors Field we hope that all our children and families feel valued members of our school community. To celebrate and show appreciation, our reception children invite their mums for tea and entertainment!

respect

Respect is an important value drawn upon during every day activities, discussions around behaviour, during assemblies and within lessons.

happy

Everyday at Priors Field we aim for the children to be happy in their learning, friendships, play and achievements.

We celebrate through our 'congratulations assemblies'.

safe

Through our PSHE curriculum and teaching Protective Behaviours, our children learn about personal safety, self-esteem, resilience and confidence building.

unique

Each child in our school is unique. Through learning, sports, music, art, and performance we like to make our children feel special and celebrate their uniqueness. The reception children invite their fathers to school to share their uniqueness through some activities outdoors.

fun

We have fun learning in our outdoor environment, messy art days, learning about food and cooking, singing and dancing!
