Amongst other benefits, we believe it would promote our ethos as a healthy, active school by giving us the flexibility to carry out more regular physical activity (more important than ever after a year of many lost sporting opportunities) without impacting on other equally important areas of the curriculum. ## School Meals, Summer 1

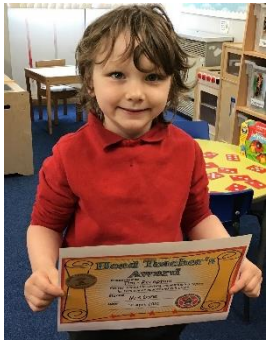
