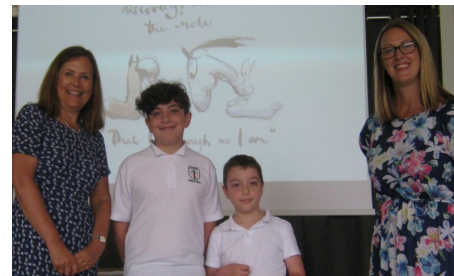


Good luck and farewell to our wonderful Italian families!
