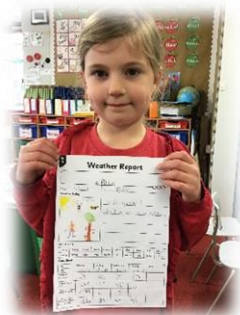
Next week we have a four-day week and school is closed for a staff training day on **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May**.
