English Key skills will be taught through this term's Linked Learning topics ' <u>Out of this World</u> ' and ' <u>Wild at Heart</u> '. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be reading and writing a variety of different fiction and non-fiction texts types including poetry, instructions, biographies, non-chronological reports and persuasive writing. We will be continuing to develop and consolidate knowledge and understanding of Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation. 		Maths <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Multiply and divide numbers up to 4 digits by a one or two digit number using a formal written method. Solve problems involving addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and a combination of these, including understanding the use of the equals sign. Compare and order fractions whose denominators are multiples of the same number. Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and denominators that are multiples of the same number. Multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers. Recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalents. Solve problems which require knowing percentage and decimal equivalents. 	Science <u>Earth and Space</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth and describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as spherical bodies. Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky. <u>Animals including Humans</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe the changes as humans develop to old age.
